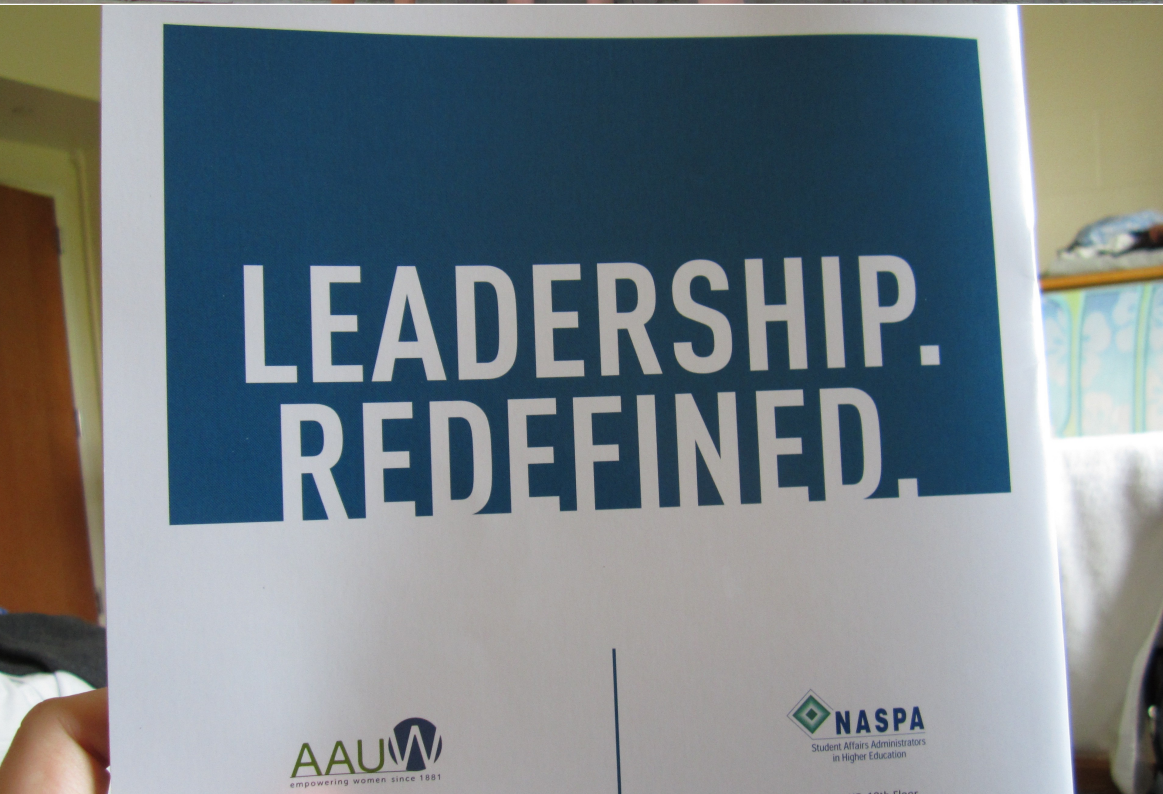
NCCWSL 2015
