

Creating and Updating a Resume

Everyone needs one to get a job regardless of your major.

How do you create an effective resume?



Resume is a document used by persons to present their backgrounds and skills. It's a one-page snapshot.

Experience (aka Employment)
Volunteering
Activities and Achievements
Additional Skills




